Rules of the Yorkshire Seniors' Amateur Championship

The County's General Competition Rules are listed on the website, www.yugc.co.uk under "Handbook-County Rules".

To be retained by the Competitor

1. It will be obligatory for all Competitors to play with a ball which is named on the current R & A List of conforming Golf Balls. Copies of which will be available at the venue.
2. The Championship shall be open to any Amateur member of a Club affiliated to the County Union who:
 - a) Has reached the age of 55 on the 19th June 2018
 - b) Is in possession of a Competition Handicap not exceeding 15.4 which has been ratified or accepted by the Union, and is not under suspension at the time of entry.
 - c) Entries cannot be accepted from players who are unable to comply with the County's Rule & Regulation 26c. (Representing another County at golf or playing in their Championship in the previous calendar year)

In the event of entries exceeding 150 there will be a ballot of the higher Handicap entrants.

3. The Competition shall be by Stroke Play from Scratch over 36 holes, and will be played by two separate rounds of 18 holes, one round being played on Monday 19th June and the other on Tuesday 20th June, with the player returning the lowest aggregate score being the winner. In the event of a tie the Championship will be decided by Count Back see Regulation 29.
Running concurrently with the Championship there will be a Stroke Play Competition from Scratch for four age groups: 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 and over.
4. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee, Rule 6-3.
5. The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R & A Rules Ltd and such Local Rules as shall be approved by the Executive Committee.
6. The Seniors' Trophy shall be awarded to the winner who will also receive a memento. Vouchers will be awarded to the Winner, 2nd and 3rd place. The leading Player aged 65 or over will become the Veterans' Champion and will be awarded the Denham Salver and receive a memento and voucher. In the Age Group Competition vouchers will be awarded in each Group for the leading 36 hole scores and for the best 18 hole score on each day. Ties for vouchers will be decided in accordance with Regulation 29 of the Rules and Regulations of the Yorkshire Union of Golf Clubs. **N.B.** No player shall take more than one prize.
7. The Championship Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall settle all disputes and other matters relating to the Championship.
8. A Competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his performance.
9. Entries on the official form and accompanied by the Entry Fee of £45 per entrant should be sent to the Honorary Secretary, YUGC, 33 George Street, Wakefield WF1 1LX, to reach **NOT LATER THAN 23rd MAY 2018**
10. Subject to the agreement of the Host Club, a competitor will be granted the use of a motorised golf buggy (should one be available) only upon the production of a medical certificate stating disability. Such a vehicle would be for the use of that competitor only
11. **Distance-Measuring Devices:** In all Yorkshire County Championships, Matches and Meetings, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses the device (including a multi-functional device such as a mobile phone) to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. Penalty: Match play – Loss of hole; Stroke play – Two strokes. Penalty for any subsequent offence: Disqualification. This Local Rule applies to team captains in both stroke play and match play Championships. If a team captain uses a device in breach of this Local Rule, any distance information sought and received by a player from that team captain or given by that team captain and willingly received by a player, will result a breach of Rule 14-3.
