



Terms of Competition for the Yorkshire Boys' Amateur Championship

1. These Terms of Competition refer to the Yorkshire Boys' Championship and should be read in conjunction with the General Terms of Competition for all Yorkshire Championships.
2. Entries, on the official form and accompanied by the Entry Fee of £15 per entrant, should be sent to YUGC Hon. Secretary, **TO REACH NOT LATER THAN 8th May 2020**. Entrants may not be able to play if their Home Club has not paid all due Affiliation Fees by that date.
3. The Championship shall be open to any Amateur member of a Club affiliated to the Union who:
 - a) Is under the age of 18 at 00:00 on the 1st January 2020
 - b) Is in possession of a Competition Handicap not exceeding 11.4 at the time of entry which has been ratified or accepted by the Union and is not under suspension at the time of entry.

In the event of entries exceeding 72 there will be a ballot of the higher Handicap entrants based on the handicap at the time of entry. This will be conducted on the basis of the exact handicap on the closing day of entry.

4. The Competition shall be by Stroke Play from Scratch over 36 holes, the player returning the lowest aggregate score being the winner. In the event of a tie, winner shall be determined by countback according to the General Terms of Competition, section 13.
5. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee.
6. The Sand Moor Trophy shall be awarded to the winner who will also receive a memento. Vouchers will be awarded by the Union. The best aggregate score by a player under the age of 16 at 00:00 on the 1st January 2020 shall be awarded the Neil Hardman Salver. In the event of a tie, winner shall be determined by countback according to the General Terms of Competition, section 13.
7. The winner shall be invited to represent the County at the England Golf Boys Champion of Champions tournament.
8. The Championship Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall settle all disputes and other matters relating to the Championship.
9. Caddies are not permitted. Penalty for breach: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum penalty per round: four strokes. A serious breach could lead to disqualification.
