



## **Terms of Competition for the Yorkshire Seniors' Amateur Championship**

1. These Terms of Competition refer to the Yorkshire Seniors' Amateur Championship and should be read in conjunction with the General Terms of Competition for all Yorkshire Championships. [Click here](#)
2. Entries, on the official form and accompanied by the Entry Fee of £45 per entrant, should be sent to YUGC Hon. Secretary, **TO REACH NOT LATER THAN 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021**. Entrants may not be able to play if their Home Club has not paid all due Affiliation Fees by that date.
3. The Championship shall be open to any Amateur member of a Club affiliated to the County Union who:
  - a. Has reached the age of 55 at 00:00 on the first day of the Championship
  - b. Is in possession of a Handicap Index not exceeding 15.4 which has been ratified or accepted by the Union and is not under suspension at the time of entry.
4. In the event of entries exceeding 150 there will be a ballot of the higher Handicap entrants.
5. The Competition shall be by Stroke Play from Scratch over 36 holes and will be played by two separate rounds of 18 holes, one round being played on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> June and the other on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> June, with the player returning the lowest aggregate score being the winner. In the event of a tie the Championship will be decided by Countback.

Running concurrently with the Championship there will be a Stroke Play Competition from Scratch for four age groups: 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 and over.
6. Competitors shall start at the time laid down by the Committee.
7. The Seniors' Trophy shall be awarded to the winner who will also receive a memento. Vouchers will be awarded to the Winner, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The leading Player aged 65 or over will become the Veterans' Champion and will be awarded the Denham Salver and receive a memento and voucher. In the Age Group Competition vouchers will be awarded in each Group for the leading 36 hole scores. Ties will be decided by countback according to the General Terms of Competition, section 13. N.B. No player shall take more than one voucher.
8. The winner shall be invited to represent the County at the England Golf Senior Champion of Champions tournament.
9. The Championship Committee, whose decision shall be final, shall settle all disputes and other matters relating to the Championship.
